

Routine Childhood and MMR Catch Up Immunisations via Enhanced Access Services, bookable by Barking & Dagenham GP Practices

Purpose: What would we like to achieve?

- Ensure children of Barking & Dagenham (B&D) are protected against the rising cases of Measles within London.
- Minimise and prevent Measles outbreaks within B&D by offering registered B&D
 patients the MMR vaccination at their GP or within the Enhanced Access (EA) Hub
 service.
- B&D patients can get their routine childhood and catch-up MMR vaccination during the evenings and weekends across the borough across all EA sites.

What's available to Practices?

- Effective immediately, B&D GP practices can utilise their PCN_Nurse EA allocations
 to book eligible patients into EA Hub service for routine childhood and catch-up
 MMR immunisations.
- **Practices** are to ensure the **reason for booking** is 'MMR/Imms' including whether the patient has requested the **gelatine-free vaccine** for MMR (Priorix).
- 100% of the Item of Service (IoS) fee is claimable via practice CQRS. There is no Federation Fee. A pathway is available at the end of this document.

Routine Childhood Immunisations for 1 – 5-year-olds (QOF)	
12 – 18 months	3 years 4 months – 5 years old
Hib and MenC	Measles, Mumps & Rubella (MMR)
Measles, Mumps & Rubella (MMR)	Diptheria, Tetanus, Pertussis and Polio (dTAP/IPV)
Men B (MenB Booster)	
Pneumococcal (PCV Booster)	

Catch Up MMR Doses (up to 25-year-old patients)	
Either 1st or 2nd dose with appropriate time interval between doses.	

100% loS claimable via Practice CQRS for the above immunisations.
